This "hands-on" laboratory course (equivalent to two credit course) will primarily simulate the discovery and rapid characterization of genes and gene products (i.e. proteins). Laboratory experiments will include cutting edge biotechnology techniques and traditional biochemical methodology. Students will be introduced to techniques including recombinant protein expression, isolation and purification, tissue culture and transfection, nucleic acid isolation and amplification (i.e. PCR), apoptotic and cell viability assays via Flow Cytometry, fluorescent microscopy, as well as the regulation of gene expression and gene silencing using siRNA.
